

Guidance For Use of GC-2010 Syntec Sanitizing Spray Concentrate

This bottle is in concentrated form - it **must** be mixed with water to be used as a spray solution. If you do not know how to properly mix the right amount of solution, **please do not do this yourself** - contact facilities@shelteringarmsny.org. Let us know your sprayer is empty and we can assist!

To disinfect areas to minimize risk of Coronavirus:

- 1) Wear protective gloves when using this product
- 2) For best effectiveness, clean soiled areas first with standard cleaning supplies;
- 3) Using Disinfectant, hold spray bottle 6 - 8 inches from surfaces/items;
- 4) Very Important: please let the disinfectant solution sit on applied surfaces for **1-3 minutes**;
- 5) Rub with brush, sponge or cloth or let it air dry;
- 6) Do your best to make sure you are not breathing in the fumes from this product



What to disinfect?

Each shift should perform targeted cleaning and disinfection of **frequently touched** hard, non-porous surfaces, including but not limited to:

- counters
- appliance surfaces
- Tabletops, desks
- doorknobs
- bathroom fixtures, toilets
- handrails
- door bells & elevator buttons
- desk phones
- cell phones, tablets, laptops
- keyboards
- remote controls
- bedside tables & dressers

To make the Disinfectant solution for a 32 Ounce Spray Bottle:

****Always wear protective gloves when using/mixing****

1. add one quarter ounce of concentrated disinfectant (.25 or ¼), per 32 ounce spray bottle. This is approximately 3 cap-fulls of disinfectant; fill the rest with water.
2. Do **not** fill the entire spray bottle with disinfectant -- it is very important that the proper amount of GC-2010 is used in the spray bottle to make sure it is effective.
